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SMALL BUSINESS ENTERPRISE INITIATIVE

Pursuant to Sec. 46-111 of the Escambia County Code of Ordinances, Escambia County has established a Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Program. The program is intended to identify eligible small businesses and encourage SBE participation in the County's procurement process. To be eligible for the SBE program, your business must meet the following requirements:

- (a) The business must currently perform a commercially useful business function.
- (b) The business must be a local business as defined in Sec. 46-110.
- (c) The business must be an independently owned and operated, for-profit entity.
- (d) The business may employ 10 or fewer full-time employees; and
- (e) The business may have a net worth of not more than one million dollars.
