Construction Notice of Commencement

Olive Road East – Phase 1 Project

Escambia County's Engineering Division will soon begin the Olive Road East – Phase 1 project in Districts 4. This roadway capacity, drainage, and reconstruction improvement project will improve the roadway condition and resolve drainage issues along this portion of the East Corridor of Olive Road. Please review the information regarding the project:

- This project is funded by Local Option Sales Tax (LOST) at a cost of \$4,531,541.
- Construction will take place beginning 16 Mar 2015 through 4 April 2017.
- The contractor, Roads, Inc. will make improvements along Olive Road, from Gregg Road to Lode Star Drive.
- Construction includes complete reconstruction to improve pedestrian and traffic capacity by providing one travel lane in each direction, and a center bidirectional turn lane, with sidewalks and bike paths.
- Drainage improvements include construction of a storm water retention pond between Lawton and Kipling Street, curbing, storm piping, drainage structures, and sidewalk inlets. Temporary drainage measures will be applied during Traffic Control Operations.
- Water line upgrades will also be installed, per Emerald Coast Utility Authority direction, resulting in brief public noticed water outages. Other temporary utility services interruptions are also expected.
- Construction will take place within the existing road right-of-way and easements, or within Temporary Work Agreement transitional areas.
- Every effort will be made by the contractor to minimize inconveniences to area residents.
- You will be provided access to your property at all times, although there may be short periods of time when the driveway may be blocked as construction progresses.
- Areas of the improvements may be temporarily disturbed, but will be returned to their previous state.
- Roadways may be blocked briefly during construction, with planned detours, lane shifts, or one-way bidirectional controlled traffic, including some night work as appropriate to apply adequate Traffic Control measures for this project, to manage vehicular and pedestrian traffic.
- An Escambia County Inspector, as well as a Construction Engineering Inspections Consultant will monitor the construction areas daily. For inspection related issues contact Hatch Mott Macdonald at 994-9898.
