**This Addendum #2 provides for the following Responses to Questions.**

1. Bidders should disregard any reference to a payment method other than EFT. Electronic Funds Transfer is the only payment method available at this time
2. Diamond Drugs d/b/a Diamond Pharmacy Services is the current provider. Escambia County currently utilizes Diamond Pharmacy under the Minnesota Multistate Contracting Alliance for Pharmacy at the contracted rates.
3. **Regarding CorrecTek:**
  - At this time, the Escambia County Jail is not using a true two-way interface (HL 7) with CorrecTek, however we are in discussions with them to upgrade to this interface. We anticipate upgrading once the bid is complete. If upgraded we would want the contracted vendor to be able to utilize this interface.
  - CorrecTek is not currently certified for EPCS using the HL7 pharmacy interface. We are on schedule to receive EPCS certification in the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2017.
  - Currently we fax orders over (electronically) this practice will continue unless and until the HL-7 interface is implemented.
4. **Regarding the Scope of Work:**
  - The electronic reconciliation and order check-in program will suffice. The controlled substance orders will need to be separated from the non-controlled substance orders. There will not be a requirement to bundle the orders.
  - The Contracted Provider must be licensed in FL.

5. **Regarding the Bid process and Bid requirements and Contract**

- The minimum requirements for bid submission are detailed in the bid documents. The County will require all of the requirements for the State of Florida and comply with all Federal Regulations whatever that is determined to be at the time of contracting for the services.
- The winning Bidder will be notified in writing of the intent to Award the contract in a timely manner.
- Bids are not altered after bid opening.
- The start time of the contract has not yet been determined.

6. There are no U.S. Marshal and ICE patients housed at the Escambia County facility.

7. **Regarding order filling and delivery:**

- The current cutoff time for next-day delivery orders is 3:00pm CST this will remain the same.
- The percentage of stock medications vs. patient specific medications- Estimate is 70% stock and 30% patient specific
- Stock is both blister packs and bottles
- Deliveries will be made **only to Escambia County Jail 2935 North L St Pensacola FL 32501.**
- Preferred method of Delivery is FED EX.
- Bidders are required to provide evidence of a FDA –registered repackager (the repacker’s license and labeler code).

8. **Regarding Contracted Pharmacy**

- Current Contracted Pharmacy is CVS.
- Medical supplies, etc. are not ordered from contracted Pharmacy.
- CVS is the afterhours pick up Pharmacy
- OTC meds are provided by the Contracted Pharmacy

9. **Regarding Actual Utilization Data:**

10. **Regarding Medication Data**

11. Escambia County currently receives a credit for medications that are returned to the pharmacy, there is not a fee associated with the return.
12. The meds are discontinued after someone has been released.
13. The Escambia County correctional facility is accredited by the National Commission on Correctional Health Care (NCCHC).
14. There is a form that is completed and signed by the Clinical Operations Coordinator and a physician to approve non-formulary requests. The physician's Medical Assistant initiates the form for signature then faxes the completed form to the pharmacy.
15. The current destruction policy for all outdated/expired drugs is -The pharmacy technician completes a destruction form and sends the medications to the contracted pharmacy for destruction.
16. The DEA Licenses are under the names of Dr. George A. Smith and Dr. Paul R. Henning.
  
17.
