Proposers:

We recently sent you a Request for Proposal on the above mentioned specification.

This Addendum #3 provides for:

**Revised Scope of Work**

The Dentist / Contractor must meet the following criteria:

- Possess current state license as a dentist through the Florida Board of Dentistry and maintain such license for the duration of the contract.
- Possess current Healthcare Provider CPR certification.
- Possess proof of pre-employment screening to include a TB skin test or chest X-Ray, professional references, criminal background check(s), and drug screening.

The Dentist / Contractor will provide general dental services as outlined below Monday – Friday during normal business hours (7:30am to 4:00pm) as needed to meet the dental needs of the inmates (patients) at the Escambia County Jail and other Escambia County Detention Facilities on an as needed basis up to a maximum of thirty (30) hours per week:

- 1) Use masks, gloves and safety glasses to protect themselves and their patients from infectious diseases.
- 2) Administer anesthetics to limit the amount of pain experienced by patients during procedures.
- 3) Examine teeth, gums, and related tissues, using dental instruments, x-rays, and other diagnostic equipment, to evaluate dental health, diagnose diseases or abnormalities, and plan appropriate treatments.
- 4) Formulate plan of treatment for patient's teeth and mouth tissue.
- 5) Use air turbine and hand instruments, dental appliances and surgical implements.
- 6) Advise and instruct patients regarding preventive dental care, the causes and treatment of dental problems, and oral health care services.
- 7) Diagnose and treat diseases, injuries, and malformations of teeth, gums and related oral structures, and provide preventive and corrective services.
- 8) Write prescriptions for antibiotics and other medications.

- 9) Analyze and evaluate dental needs to determine changes and trends in patterns of dental disease.
- 10) Eliminate irritating margins of fillings and correct occlusions, using dental instruments.
- 11) Perform oral surgery on the jaw or mouth.
- 12) Remove diseased tissue using surgical instruments on a case by case basis
- 13) Plan, organize, and maintain dental health programs.
- 14) Produce and evaluate dental health educational materials.
- 15) Other duties as assigned or required to fulfill dental needs of the inmate / patient population.
