Jackson Lakes Maintenance Yard & Hurd Lane Slope Repair Project

Project Overview

Escambia County's Engineering Division will soon begin the Jackson Lakes Maintenance Yard and Hurd Lane Slope Repair Project in District 2. This project is necessary due to the damage caused by the April 2014 flood event. Construction will include erosion repair and slope improvements, and is expected to be underway from October through January 2017, pending weather conditions.



- The project will be submitted to the Federal Emergency Management Agency for reimbursement at an estimated project construction cost of \$470,940.
- Construction will take place during the hours of 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- Improvement areas may be temporarily disturbed, but will be returned to their previous state.
- Access to your property will be provided at all times, although there may be short periods when a driveway or entrance may be blocked as construction progresses.
- Every effort will be made by the contractor to minimize inconveniences to area residents.
- An Escambia County inspector will monitor the construction areas daily.
- We appreciate your cooperation and patience during the construction process.
