Crockett Street & Crestfield Circle Drainage Improvements Project Phase 1

Project Overview

Escambia County's Construction Management Division will soon begin Phase I of the Crockett Street & Crestfield Circle Drainage Improvements Project in District 5. The Blue Pit regional stormwater pond is located west of Pine Forest Road and south of West Roberts Road. This project involves the expansion of the Blue Pit pond and drainage improvements that route stormwater from along Crockett Street and West Roberts Road to the pond to alleviate area flooding. Construction is expected from May through November, weather permitting.



Resident Information

- Construction costs of approximately \$370,000 will be funded by Local Options Sales Tax.
- The contractor, Chavers Construction, Inc., will limit construction activities to the county's existing drainage easements, and the public rights of way.
- The project includes construction of 333 linear feet of concrete swales, tied concrete block, three outfall structures with energy dissipators, placement of rip-rap material and other stormwater drainage related materials including excavation and stabilization of side slopes.
- The project does not include utility relocation or installation.
- Construction is expected to take place Monday through Saturday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Long-term obstructions in the road right of way are not anticipated.
- Areas planned to be temporarily disturbed will be returned to their previous state.
- Access to your property will be provided at all times, although there may be short periods when a driveway or an entrance may be temporarily blocked as equipment and materials are moved during construction.
- Every effort will be made by the contractor to minimize inconveniences to area residents.
- An Escambia County inspector will monitor the construction areas daily.
- We appreciate your cooperation and patience during this construction process.
