Call to order. 2 call to order today's meeting of the Escambia County 3 Board of Electrical Examiners. In attendance are 4 myself, James Simmons, Tom McElhany, and Mr. Johnny 5 6 Scapin. We have a quorum. Pledge of Allegiance. 7 (Whereupon, the Pledge of Allegiance was 8 9 recited) 10 MS. HAMPTON: You guys are inconsistent. 11 MR. SIMMONS: It's been a minute. At least we're catching up. I remember from Boy Scouts. 12 Okay. Proof of publication? 1.3 MS. HAMPTON: Yes, sir, Mr. Chairman. 14 published on November 13th, 2025, in the Pensacola 15 News Journal. 16 MR. SIMMONS: Approval of minutes? 17 MS. HAMPTON: I'll bring those up. 18 (Whereupon, Mr. Hawkins entered the meeting) 19 20 MS. HAMPTON: If you could just add it to the record that Mr. Hawkins has joined us. 2.1 MR. HAWKINS: Morning. 2.2 MR. SIMMONS: Mr. Hawkins has joined our 23 24 meeting. MR. SCAPIN: At his regular time. 25

1	MR. HAWKINS: Actually, I'm early today by three
2	minutes, sir.

13	Our first or only applicant to appear before
14	you today is Mr. Kenneth Stevens.
15	Mr. Stevens, if you will please come to the
16	podium, state your name and address for the record.
17	MR. STEVENS: Hello. My name is Ken Stevens.
18	My I reside at 5467 Education Drive.
19	MS. HAMPTON: Can y'all hear him?
20	MR. MORENO: I'll turn the mic on for you.
21	MS. HAMPTON: There you go.
22	MR. STEVENS: Hello. My name is Kenneth
23	Stevens. I reside at 5467 Pace Education Drive in
24	Milton. I've resided there since 2002.
25	MR. MORENO: Board Members, Mr. Stevens appears

before you today requesting to reciprocate his
electrical license from Santa Rosa County. He's held
this license since November 13th, 2013, to the
present, totaling two years and five days.

MS. HAMPTON: '23. You said 2013.

MR. MORENO: Of 2023, forgive me.

Outside of that experience, he has provided additional experience as an IT director for Santa Rosa County Clerk of Courts from 2001 to 2019. He's also provided additional educational experience with a master's degree in information systems, bachelor's degree in information systems, certificate of fundamentals of Cisco router configuration, and the Novel Education 4.11 Administration. Because this is a reciprocity, we will defer to the Board for a decision to allow this reciprocity or deny it.

MR. SIMMONS: Can you remind the experience requirement?

MS. HAMPTON: Yes, sir. So the experience requirement is four years. Mr. Stevens was made aware that whenever we were vetting his application, that in our review, he did not meet that requirement; however, Mr. Stevens requested to complete his case before this Board.

MR. MCELHANY: You want to complete your case,

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then?

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MR. STEVENS: I know that I am a couple of years earlier asking permission to work in Escambia County, but I do feel that I am qualified to meet those goals. And the — per the codes that are up to date that are in place by the state of Florida, and also tailor—made to each county within the state of Florida. I have been abiding by those codes. And I am an associate with Home Depot, that — with a Home Depot Pro Team, that has performed electrical projects within Santa Rosa County. And I would appreciate to work in Escambia County.

I do own my own property in Milton and Pace, Florida area. I also own land in Escambia County. And I am licensed and insured with up to approximately \$1 million policy. I can continue with — but I think I've got a limit of what I can say here.

MR. MCELHANY: Well, personally, I'm sorry that you went through all of this, but I don't see the possibility of approving this. You know, IT technology is definitely a lot to it, but we have to protect the citizens of this county, you know, and make sure the people are experienced in what they are doing and that's the reason for the four years of

1 experience.

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MR. STEVENS: And I could further the electrical experience that I have in the past forty years that I've worked in the electronic arena.

MR. MCELHANY: Well, that wouldn't enter into this application, unless you could get an employer to say that, you know, on a notarized sheet, of your experience that all those things that you were doing electrically and that that employer was licensed to do those electrical things. You know, and your form, it's just — a lot leaves to be desired on explaining what you have been doing for the past two years even. So, you know, I would suggest, you know, sticking to it for two more years and coming back with a whole lot more explanation and then it would fly right through. That's my opinion.

MR. SIMMONS: Ms. Jennifer, regarding the four years, isn't there some additional caveat, four in the last six or something like that?

MS. HAMPTON: So what I'll do is bring up our muni code in relation to the requirements on that. Different jurisdictions have different requirements, and the state has different requirements. But I can visually show you what our requirements are. And then, also, within our application, there is — you

have to check which box you meet because we have the apprenticeship program. We have different programs that you can complete that would also qualify you, so many hours of certain things.

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MR. SCAPIN: Mr. Stevens, have you gone through any kind of apprenticeship program?

MR. STEVENS: In the electrical field, I've only taken the test at Pensacola State College in Milton campus for the masters license. I also completed the Florida Business and Law exam. And I've had various experiences in technology, as far as designing power supplies, also working with the military in west Germany, as far as rectifying their generators. I don't want to really get into all of that.

But I have been in the electrical arena of my career for forty years. I do know how electrons flow through the media. I do know the different types of media and their conductivity. I have since learned in the last two years about honing in on the electrical side of the electronics. I admit there was items that I did not practice every day in that forty-year career, but I have been aware of now that there are all certain codes. And these codes are massive, but I've mastered the technique and learning how to look for these codes and their definitions and

what to follow when I approach a particular job in question.

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And these jobs are unique in nature. They basically vary from residential, commercial, which I am licensed to perform these duties in. In those specific areas, commercial and residential, I know there are issues that have to be addressed. When you're approaching a residence that has, for example, swimming pools, they're going to have different requirements for your electrical outlet installations.

MS. HAMPTON: So on your screen before you is the requirement for application with this Board. Reciprocity is treated the same as if they were going for examination. They must meet these requirements. They are to turn in their application. They have to have at least four years related working experience in the construction trade satisfactory to the Board, so that means you have to approve it.

The proof shall consist of one of these -- a combination of these things, which would be the apprenticeship program, an employer certifying four years of experience, a master electrician or electrical contractor's license and four years working experience, or a degree in electrical

engineering or electrical technology and two years of 1 experience. Along with that, they have to pay a fee 2 and they have two references, so --3 MR. HAWKINS: I think I see where your degree is 4 in information systems? 5 6 MR. STEVENS: Yes, sir. 7 MR. HAWKINS: What would it take for you to go back and finish the -- and actually get a degree in 8 the electrical field? 9 10 MR. STEVENS: I didn't catch the last part of that question. 11 MR. HAWKINS: Would it be to your advantage to 12 go back and try to get the degree in the electrical 13 engineering or electrical technology field, ensuring 14 that two years up, the actual two years of experience 15 that you need? 16 MR. MCELHANY: He would still need two years 17 experience in that field. 18 MR. HAWKINS: Because with that, you only have 19 20 to have two years of experience, which you have. MR. STEVENS: Yeah. When I first started my 2.1 education in this field, it was in 1977. And I went 2.2 to a school called Tampa Technical Institute, and I 23 have received an AA degree in that, in the 24 electronic/computer systems; and then, basically, 25

that's where I've gotten my experience also. And throughout the years --

MR. HAWKINS: I was just trying to just reach in the air to see if there is anything here that, from the Board's standpoint, we could be able to assist you. And my thought was, if it's not too much, maybe with the existing degree that you had, you could go and take some additional courses maybe for a year and come up with the degree that you need in the electrical technology field, and that could help you with — so you could shorten up your time is what I'm trying to say.

MR. STEVENS: I understand.

MR. SCAPIN: Mr. Chairman, I'm going to have to agree with Mr. McElhany on the two years experience. It's not quite -- he needs two more years.

MR. SIMMONS: Yeah. The ordinance seems to reflect electrical engineering degree and two years of work experience, or four years of notarized experience. So, a double E degree or someone to, you know, get some additional reference for work experience, because we are just shy of two years. Is my math right?

MS. HAMPTON: That's correct.

MR. MORENO: Just over.

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MR. SIMMONS: Mr. Stevens, is there, you know --1 it looks like we have information from 2001 to 2019, 2 and then there's a gap. Is there some work 3 experience authorization that we can get to fill in 4 some of that gap to show four years? 5 6 MR. STEVENS: From -- are you referring to the end of 2019 --7 MR. SIMMONS: -- yes, sir. 9 MR. STEVENS: -- up to date? 10 Well, the last two years I have been in business, but those years in between in question, I 11 retired and I basically wanted to start something 12 with my life again and company. I thought about what 1.3 could I do, and I decided to enter the electrical 14 field. 15 MR. SIMMONS: Yes, sir. That's fair. 16 Do we have a motion? 17 MR. MCELHANY: I'm going to make a motion we 18 decline his application for the reciprocity. 19 20 MR. HAWKINS: Reciprocity. MR. SIMMONS: We have a motion. Do we have a 2.1 second? 2.2 MR. SCAPIN: Second. 23 MR. SIMMONS: All in favor? 24 MR. HAWKINS: Aye. 25

MR. SCAPIN: Aye. 1 MR. MCELHANY: Aye. 2 MR. SIMMONS: 3 Aye. MR. SCAPIN: Good luck to you, sir. 4 MR. STEVENS: Okay. Thank you. 5 6 MS. HAMPTON: Mr. Stevens, if you happen to get 7 additional documentation on experience, please bring it back to us, or continue working and then we can 8 9 definitely go through this process. 10 MR. STEVENS: Sure. I can do that. Appreciate 11 the opportunity. MS. HAMPTON: Yes, sir. 12 MR. SIMMONS: Ms. Jennifer, I have a question. 1.3 There was some discussion last meeting about 14 15 restrictions on the Santa Rosa County ER license regarding being residential only, or something to 16 that effect. 17 MS. HAMPTON: Right. 18 MR. SIMMONS: Did we ever get any clarification 19 20 on that? MS. HAMPTON: I did not. I can't find anything 2.1 within their --2.2 MR. MCELHANY: I talked to somebody, another 23 contractor. He said that's got to be -- he had to 24 have only had a residential only state license. 25

1	MS. HAMPTON: Yeah, it's state license.
2	MR. MCELHANY: Yeah.
3	MS. HAMPTON: And they do break that down there
4	within the state. I don't see anything from that
5	jurisdiction that breaks it down. We do not break it
6	down.
7	MR. MCELHANY: No.
8	MS. HAMPTON: We have a one and done kind of
9	thing, unless you going low voltage, alarm, those,
10	like, little categories, master electrician, either
11	or.
12	MR. MCELHANY: But the man last month, his
13	employer should have explained it better to him
14	MS. HAMPTON: Correct.
15	MR. MCELHANY: when he told him that, for him
16	to come out saying things to people.
17	MR. SIMMONS: We being such close neighbors, it
18	would be nice to see more consistency, of course.
19	MR. MCELHANY: What do you mean?
20	MR. SIMMONS: Well, even the work experience
21	MR. MCELHANY: Well, even Escambia County, you
22	can get a state residential only license, can't you?
23	MS. HAMPTON: No. We don't have a residential
24	electrician's license.
25	MR. MCELHANY: I mean, if you get how did he

get his; through the state, or, I mean --1 MS. HAMPTON: I would have to dig deeper into 2 what he actually did and how he applied and who he 3 applied to, to find out but --4 MR. HAWKINS: So in other words, he could have 5 6 reciprocity from someone else to go to Santa Rosa and still --7 MS. HAMPTON: He could have, yeah. I would have 8 to go down that rabbit hole and find out. 9 10 here, we don't have that. MR. MCELHANY: Okay. 11 MS. HAMPTON: And we just had a license -- a 12 request for a license yesterday that we don't have 13 that license type. They were going to have to go 14 through the state, and it had to do with pools. But 15 if we don't have it, we can't necessarily honor it 16 from another jurisdiction. 17 MR. MCELHANY: Even if it's an EC license or 18 something? 19 20 MS. HAMPTON: If it's an EC, that's a state certified, we would have to. 2.1 MR. MCELHANY: Well, the residential license, is 2.2 it an EC or an ERC? 23 The gentleman that came in here 24 MS. HAMPTON: before, it was a registered license. It was not a 25

state certified license, because he wouldn't have 1 come in here at all. We would have just registered 2 him with us. 3 MR. MCELHANY: Well, we are getting too far out 4 of there. On his application, I wonder what his 5 6 experience verification said about his employer, what 7 his license number was from his past employer. MS. HAMPTON: If I'm not mistaken, his past 8 employer was an ER, which means master electrician 9 10 registered. MR. MCELHANY: Right. Okay. So, that's -- we 11 don't have the right information there or something. 12 MS. HAMPTON: Yeah. I would never want to say 1.3 14 that, but I think maybe there was some confusion with it. 15 Yes, sir? 16 MR. SCAPIN: Who is the newbie? 17 MS. HAMPTON: Oh, Bobby. This is Bobby 18 Whitmire. He normally comes in and sits with our 19 20 Contractor Competency Board. Bobby's background is in structural. He came to the county a few years 2.1 back, and has made his way up the ranks. And he is 2.2 now a chief of building. So I told him that he 23 should come sit in with this board just to see how it 24 25 goes.

It's vastly different how Contractor Competency 1 Board is. Y'all are a little bit more laid back. 2 More strict, but it is a more laid back board. And 3 so I told him that he should come sit in here and 4 that's because Mr. Eddy just decided to show up 5 6 whenever he wanted. 7 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: I was missing you at your desk. I wonder where she sent to. 8 9 MS. HAMPTON: You just forgot, huh? 10 MR. SCAPIN: I was real surprised to see Mr. Eddy. 11 MR. MCELHANY: I didn't even recognize him. 12 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Oh, man. Now, 13 Johnny, you ought to not throw me under the bus. 14 MR. HAWKINS: He throws everybody under the bus 15 except himself. 16 MS. HAMPTON: But, yes, Bobby is not necessarily 17 new to the chief position. He's been doing it for a 18 while, but I have been dragging him to different 19 20 things so he can experience it. MR. SCAPIN: Good deal. 2.1 MS. HAMPION: Well, happy Thanksgiving to all of 2.2 23 you. 24 MR. MCELHANY: You, too. MR. SIMMONS: 25 Same.




