Construction Notice of Commencement

East Johnson Avenue Drainage Improvement Project

Project Overview

Escambia County's Engineering Division will soon begin the East Johnson Avenue Drainage Project in District 3. This project will make repairs to the storm-sewer trunk line damaged by the April 2014 flood, as well as sidewalk replacement of approximately 95 linear feet. The work will take place along the south side of East Johnson Avenue (within the roadway shoulder area) from Hitchcock Road to 600 feet east of Forge Lane. Construction is expected to begin in October and continue through February 2017, pending contractor availability and weather conditions.





Resident Information

- The project is a Local Agency Program project and will be submitted to the Federal Highway Administration for reimbursement. Construction cost is estimated at \$238,043.
- Southern Utility Co. Inc. will be the contractor for this project and will limit construction activities to the county's existing drainage easements and within the public right of way.
- Mott MacDonald will provide Construction Engineering Inspection services for this project and will monitor the construction areas daily.
- Construction is expected to take place during the hours of 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Saturday.
- Long-term obstructions in the road right of way are not anticipated.
- Improvement areas may be temporarily disturbed before being returned to their previous state.
- You will be provided access to your property at all times, although there may be short periods when a driveway or an entrance may be temporarily blocked as equipment and materials are moved to make repairs.
- Every effort will be made by the contractor to minimize inconveniences to area residents.
