Innerarity Island Sewer Expansion Project

Notice of Upcoming Construction

ECUA Project No. CS318T

Dear Property Owner:

ECUA, in cooperation with Escambia County, is about to initiate a construction project to provide upgraded sewer service to your neighborhood (see attached map). The Innerarity Island Sewer Expansion Project (IISEP) is part of ECUA's Sewer System Expansion Program. The goal of the IISEP is to: (1) replace the existing, substandard sanitary sewer system/ facilities, in the Innerarity Island and Russell Bayou communities, as previously discussed in public meetings; and (2) to make public sewer service available to properties utilizing septic tanks, which may pose public health or environmental risks.

CONTACT / SCHEDULE

Engineering oversight will be provided by ECUA and our engineering consultant, Kenneth Horne & Associates. Construction is scheduled to begin in October 2019 and will take about ten months to complete (Fall 2020). Refer to the attached "Contact List" sheet for individuals to contact concerning issues or questions regarding funding or construction.

IMPACTS

The majority of the proposed sewer installation work will occur within the rights-of-way of the streets shown on the attached map. We anticipate there will be disruptions to some normal traffic patterns during construction. ECUA and the contractor will make every effort to minimize those disruptions. There may be detours required from time to time; however, access to your property will be maintained to the maximum extent



possible. As with any large construction project, there will be noise, dust, rough pavement and heavy equipment operating in the area for the duration of the project. Your cooperation and patience are appreciated. ECUA's goal is to complete the work as quickly as possible with minimal inconvenience.

VACANT LOTS

All properties connected to a sewer system are required to pay a one-time Impact Fee at the time of initial development. ECUA's current Wastewater Capacity Impact Fee is \$1,602.00 for a residential service but is subject to change over time. Most have already paid this; however, each property owner of a vacant lot must pay the Impact Fee at the time the property is developed regardless of when the connection is made. The Impact Fee is in addition to the owner purchasing and installing a grinder pump and the annual MSBU allotment (which will be less than properties having a grinder pump installed as part of the project).

SEPTIC TANKS

The abandonment of existing septic tanks will require the installation of grinder pumps on each individual property. The contractor, Talcon Group, will be required to contact you to coordinate all activities and confirm the desired location of your grinder pump and connection point. You should select a location that will make it as simple and cost-effective as possible to connect your house plumbing to the new service line. You will receive a letter from the Escambia County Health Department upon completion of construction, which is your notification that the sewer is available and active.

Please note that Section 381.00655 Florida Statutes and Escambia County Ordinances Number 99-24 and 99-36 require that "the owner of a properly functioning onsite sewage treatment and disposal system (septic tank) must connect the system or the building's plumbing to an available publicly owned or investor-owned sewerage system within 365 days after written notification by the owner of the publicly owned or investor-owned sewerage system that the system is available for connection". If an individual utilizing a septic tank chose not to participate within the aforementioned timeframe, the owner would be faced with providing his/her own grinder pump, paying to abandon the existing septic system, and payment of the Wastewater Capacity Impact Fee.

Thank you in advance for your patience and understanding through the construction of these improvements. As noted, the Escambia County Health Department will notify you in writing when the project is complete. ECUA is committed to providing you with quality


