The Florida Department of Commerce (FloridaCommerce) is pleased to inform you that your project has been selected to receive Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funds based on the Century Drainage and Road Improvements application submitted to the Rebuild Florida Infrastructure Repair Program.
