### Objectives:

- To Educate Minority Vendors On How To Do Business With The Escambia County School District (ECSD).
- To Provide Best Practices For Quotes/Bids/RFPs/Construction.
- To Encourage Registration And Certification With The FL Dept. Of Management Services Office Of Supplier Diversity (OSD) And To Utilize OSD Resources.
- To Increase ECSD Partnerships With Local Minority Organizations To Promote Vendor Events.
- To Counter Community Perception That Business Opportunities Are Not Available For Minority Vendors With The ECSD.

### Per School Board Rule 6Gx17-5.02(15)(A)(1-4) Definitions:

- A Small, Minority, Or Service Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise That Employs 200 Or Less Permanent Full-Time Employees And Has A Net Worth Of No More Than \$5 Million Dollars.
- Engages In Commercial Transactions Domiciled In Florida.
- A Minority Business Enterprise Is At Least 51% Owned, Managed, And Controlled By African-American, American Women, Asian-American, Hispanic-American, And Native American US Citizens And Permanent FL Residents.
- A Service Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise Is At Least 51% Owned By A Service Disabled Veteran Who Has A Disability Of 10% Or More That Was Incurred Or Aggravated In The Line Of Duty In The Active Service In The US Armed Forces.

## Purchasing Guidelines

- Purchases Under \$10,000 Require A Minimum Of One (1) Quote.
- Purchases From \$10,001 to \$49,999 Require Three Quotes, An Existing Competitively Bid Contract, Or Sole Source Designation.
- Purchases From \$50,000 or More Require A Formal Bid Solicitation, Request For Proposal (RFP), An Existing Competitively Bid Contract, Or Sole Source Designation.

### **Purchasing Overview**

- 2020-2021 Total Purchases Approx. \$409 Million
- Opportunities For Small Dollar Purchases Under \$10,000 Include But Not Limited To:
  - Schools, PTA, Booster Clubs (Specialty Items, Etc.)
  - Custodial/Maintenance (Janitorial Supplies, Small Repair/Installation Work, Etc.)
  - Educational Consulting/Professional Development (Title I / Curriculum & Instruction)
- Opportunities For Large Dollar Purchases From \$10,000 To Over \$50,000 Include But Not Limited To:
  - Custodial/Maintenance (Quotes, Bid/RFP Solicitations)
  - Facilities Planning (General or Sub-Contractors)
  - Educational Consulting/Professional Development (Title I / Curriculum & Instruction)

#### Best Practices for Quotes And Bid/RFP Solicitations

- Read The Entire Document Twice To Fully Understand The Terms, Conditions, And Specifications Or Scope Of Work.
- Highlight Dates And Times To Submit Your Questions, Samples, And Response.
- Review The Purchasing Website For Current Or Prior Bid/RFP Award Tabulations.
- All Documents Should Be Readable.
- Reference The Solicitation Number On All Additional Sheets.
- Prior To Submitting, Review Your Response To Ensure All Required Attachments And Copies Are Included And Signed.
- Be Ready To Comply With Fingerprinting/Background Check Requirements.
- Be Realistic About Your Business Capabilities And Do Not Overpromise!
