
Construction Notice of Commencement

Hallendale Drive Pipe Rehabilitation and Replacement Project

Project Overview

The Escambia County Engineering Division will soon begin the Hallendale Drive Pipe Lining Project in District 1. The project is located adjacent to 6694 Hallendale Drive in the Clear Creek Subdivision. This project consists of removing and replacing a section of damaged 24 inch corrugated plastic pipe located within the right of way. The project will also replace a section of the existing driveway, curbing, and asphalt roadway at 6694 Hallendale Drive, and will install approximately 180 linear feet of cast-in-place pipe liner to rehabilitate the damaged pipe.





Resident Information

Information regarding the Hallendale Drive Pipe Rehabilitation and Replacement Project:

- Construction is expected to occur from November to December 2018, weather permitting.
- Construction costs of approximately \$44,409 will be funded by Local Option Sales Tax.
- Pensacola Concrete Construction Company Inc. is the contractor for this project.
- Construction activities will be limited to the county's existing drainage easement areas and the public right of way.
- Construction is expected to take place Monday through Saturday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Long-term obstructions in the public right of way are not anticipated.
- Areas planned to be temporarily disturbed will be returned to their previous state.
- You will be provided access to your property at all times, although there may be short periods when a driveway or entrance may be temporarily blocked as equipment and materials are moved during construction.
- Every effort will be made by the contractor to minimize inconveniences to area residents.
- An Escambia County inspector will monitor the construction areas daily.
- Your cooperation and patience are appreciated during this construction process.
