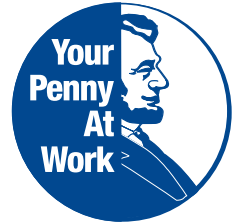


Construction Notice of Commencement

Ponderosa Drive Pond Expansion Project

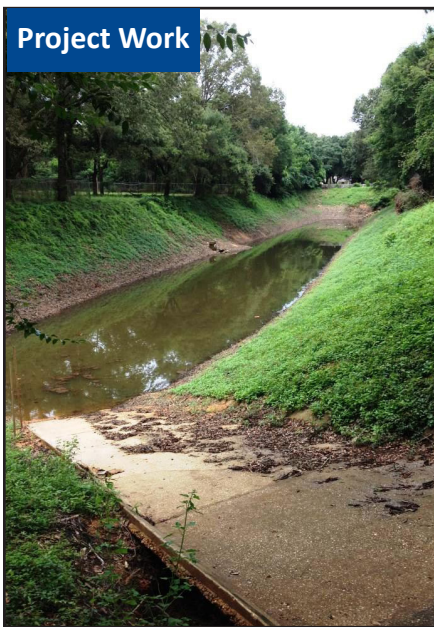
Project Overview

Escambia County's Engineering Division will soon begin the Ponderosa Drive Pond Expansion Project in District 5. This project is intended to provide relief to existing drainage problems in the area by expanding the existing stormwater pond. Construction is expected to begin in September 2016 and continue through June 2017, pending contractor availability and weather conditions.



Resident Information

- The project is funded by the Local Option Sales Tax at a construction cost of \$556,000.
- The contractor, Principle Properties, Inc., will limit construction activities to the area of the county's existing drainage easement areas, and public rights of way.
- Construction improvements consist of expanding the size of the existing stormwater pond. The pond will increase by approximately three acres while maintaining the same depth. The stormwater collection system around the pond will be improved to accommodate the pond expansion.
- Construction is expected to take place during the hours of 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Saturday.
- No long-term obstructions in the rights of way are anticipated.
- Improvement areas may be temporarily disturbed before being returned to their previous state.
- Residents will be provided access to their property at all times, although there may be short periods when a driveway or an entrance may be temporarily blocked as equipment or materials are moved to make repairs.
- An Escambia County inspector will monitor the construction areas daily.
- Every effort will be made by the contractor to minimize inconveniences to area residents.
