
Construction Notice of Commencement

Valkyry Way Drainage Improvement Project

Project Overview

Escambia County's Engineering Division will soon begin the Valkyry Way Drainage Improvement Project in District 5. This project consists of roadway widening and drainage improvements on Valkyry Way. Construction is expected from February through July, weather permitting.





Resident Information

- Construction costs of approximately \$231,407 will be funded through the Municipal Service Benefit Unit.
- Roads, Inc., the contractor for this project, will limit construction activities to the area of the county's existing drainage easements, and the public rights of way acquired though the MSBU.
- The project will consist of other work associated with the roadway widening and drainage improvements such as installing a cul-de-sac at the end of the road, installing curbing, replacing the culvert under the roadway and constructing swales and ditches along Valkyry Way.
- Work is expected to take place Monday through Saturday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Long-term obstructions in the road rights of way are not anticipated.
- Areas planned to be temporarily disturbed will be returned to their previous state.
- You will be provided access to your property at all times, although there may be periods when a driveway or an entrance may be temporarily blocked as equipment and materials are moved during construction.
- Every effort will be made by the contractor to minimize inconveniences to area residents.
- An Escambia County inspector will monitor the construction areas daily.
