Construction is expected October - November, weather permitting.

Information regarding the Imperial Drive Pipe Lining Project:

- Construction costs of approximately \$34,797 will be funded by LOST.
- The Contractor, Pensacola Concrete Construction Co., Inc., will limit construction activities to the area of the county's existing drainage easements, and the public right-of-way.
- Construction is expected to take place Monday through Saturday, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Long-term obstructions in the road right-of-way are not anticipated.
- Areas planned to be temporarily disturbed will be returned to their previous state.
- You will be provided access to your property at all times, although there may be short periods
 when a driveway or an entrance may be temporarily blocked as equipment and materials
 are moved during construction.
- Every effort will be made by the contractor to minimize inconveniences to area residents.
- An Escambia County Inspector will monitor the construction areas daily.
- We appreciate your cooperation and patience during this construction process.
