



Background

- On March 21, 2014, the court ordered the County to become the receiver of IIDC, an abandoned wastewater and water utility.
- Water Service Upgrade Complete and transitioned to ECUA
- ECUA has agreed to oversee and manage the upgrades to the sewer system on Innerarity Island.
- Once upgraded to ECUA standards, ECUA will take over ownership and maintenance of the sewer system on Innerarity Island.

Grinder Pump / Lift Station

- Grinder Pump a small private pump located on your property (typically in the home) to pump wastewater into the low-pressure transmission system (pipe in front of you home)
- Lift Station A Wet Well designed to handle wastewater from gravity or low-pressure systems. The well is equipped with electrical instrumentation to detect the level of sewage present. When the sewage level rises to a predetermined point, a pump will be started to pump the sewage upward through a pressurized pipe system called a *sewer force main* to a treatment facility.







Design / Construction Status


- Currently at 90% plans (Full size set for you to review)

Septic to Sewer Willingness

- Current Transition
 - County will arrange for a contractor/plumber to properly abandon your existing septic tank, install a new grinder pump, and connect to the new low-pressure sewer line.
- Postponed Transition
 - You can remain on your septic system
 - If you apply for a future permit or until your septic tank needs service, the Health Department will require you to transition to the low-pressure system.
 - You will be required to purchase a grinder pump, hire a plumber to install and connect to the system, and pay any sewer user fee to ECUA as required (after first year)
