



## Summer Wheels Pass Enrollment Form

Youth ages 18 and under can ride Escambia County Area Transit unlimited with the Summer Wheels Program. Summer Wheels passes allow unlimited rides and transfers from Memorial Day until Labor Day. Only one pass will be issued per person. <u>Youth are not permitted to obtain a pass without a parent/guardian present.</u>

Passes are issued at Escambia County Area Transit, 1515 West Fairfield Drive, Pensacola, Florida. To obtain your pass:

- 1. Complete this form and sign below (both youth and parent/guardian must sign).
- 2. Provide proof of age/identification.
- 3. Pick up the Summer Wheels Pass

## Conduct Guidelines
