#### **Support Services**

Support services include both pre- and post-counseling for all homebuyer participants; financial, credit and budget counseling as needed; printed materials concerning maintenance and repairs of home; title clearance support and referrals to legal service agencies; and support service materials. Services are provided by SHIP staff, lenders, CEII, local non-profit agencies, or HUD approved counseling services or other local social service agencies as needed.

#### Other Accomplishments

SHIP continues to a critical resource for first time homebuyers. Housing repair assistance is another important resource for low income owner occupants, particularly elderly residents.

The City of Pensacola appointed citizens to a special Affordable Housing Task force in January 2020 and has held multiple public meetings with the goal of creating "500 Homes in 5 Years." The City secured the services of the Florida Housing Coalition to help facilitate the task force meetings, with a final report provided in August 2020 providing action steps for the City to implement.

#### Availability for Public Inspection and Comments

Annual report was made available via County website September 2020. A public notice was published on the County website on September 15, 2020 with any comments to be submitted to FHFC within 30 days. The report is also available by request to County or City housing offices. No comments have been received to date.
