

Important Notice for Beggs Lane Campers

- Gov. DeSantis has signed House Bill 1365, which prohibits camping or sleeping on public property. HB 1365 goes into effect on **Oct. 1, 2024**.
- Additionally, county-owned properties near Beggs Lane have existing deed restrictions from the Environmental Protection Agency that prohibit residential use, including camping.
- These restrictions and the new state law will impact the Beggs Lane encampment.
