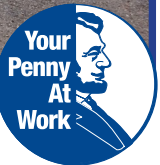
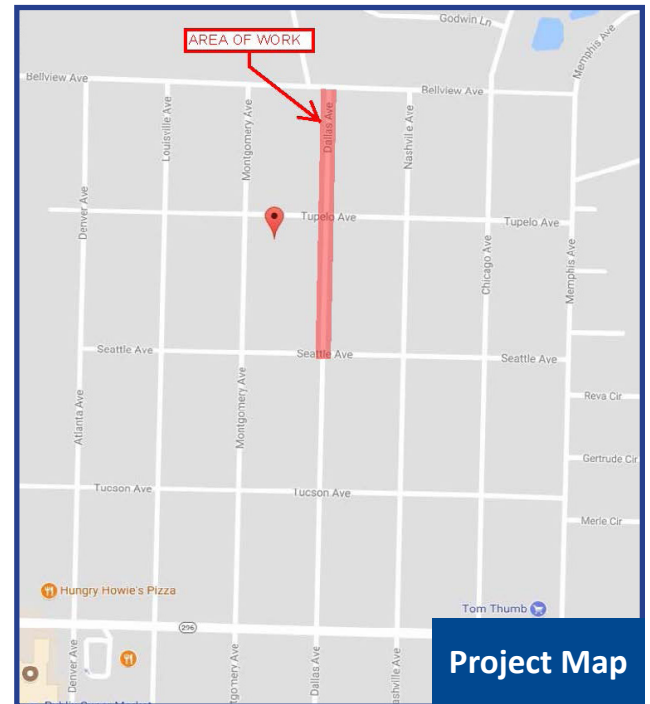
Dallas Avenue Drainage Improvement Project

Project Overview

Escambia County's Engineering Division will soon begin the Dallas Avenue Drainage Improvement Project in District 1. This project consists of installing a new stormwater water conveyance system along Dallas Avenue between Bellview and Seattle avenues. Construction is expected December through June 2018, weather permitting.

Resident Information

- This project will be funded by Local Option Sales Tax with construction costs of approximately \$287,503.
- The contractor, Allsouth Construction Services, will limit construction activities to the existing drainage easements and public right-of-way.
- Construction improvements include: 1,126 feet of 36" drainage pipe and 151 feet of 18" drainage pipe, installing 15 inlets along Dallas Avenue, reconstructing the intersection at Dallas Avenue and Tupelo Avenue, replacing sidewalk, installing approximately 1,245 feet of 6" water line, and installing a new fire hydrant.
- Construction is expected to take place Monday through Saturday, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Long-term obstructions within the rights of way are not anticipated.
- Areas planned to be temporarily disturbed will be returned to their previous state.
- You will be provided access to your property at all times, although there may be short periods when a driveway or an entrance may be temporarily blocked as equipment and materials are moved during construction.
- Every effort will be made by the contractor to minimize inconveniences to area residents.
- An Escambia County inspector will monitor the construction areas daily.
- We appreciate your cooperation and patience during this construction process.
