## CURBSIDE PLACEMENT INFO

- Please keep tires and paint cans separate from all other debris.
   Do not place piles under low-hanging lines or near poles, fences or mailboxes.
- All debris must be at the curb directly in front of your residence by 7 a.m. on the scheduled day of cleanup.

#### ITEMS ELIGIBLE FOR REMOVAL INCLUDE:

- Household appliances and electronics
- Yard waste Household junk and debris
- Bicycles and toys Barbecue grills
- Old furniture and mattresses
- Household hazardous waste (old paint, motor oil, chemicals, batteries)
- Tires (limit 10 per household)

#### ITEMS **NOT** ELIGIBLE FOR REMOVAL:

- Building materials (concrete, bricks, blocks, roofing, drywall or lumber)
   Auto parts
- Explosives or ammunition Dirt or sod
- Vehicles/vessels
  55-gallon drums of fluids
