



Guidance for Presentations to the Escambia County RESTORE Advisory Committee

The purpose of these presentations is to advise the committee on the criteria they should consider for evaluation of future RESTORE project submissions. To meet the Committee's needs:

- Criteria should be listed clearly and concisely.
- Why the committee should use this criteria and what issues are pressing in Escambia County that makes this criteria important should be stated.

Presenters are to follow these guidelines:

- This is an educational presentation, not a marketing presentation
- Present **fact based criteria** on challenges facing the economy, environment or infrastructure of Escambia County
- Present possible solutions to the challenges identified above
 - Do **NOT** use this time to forward your favorite project/program
- Possible solutions presented must be allowed by the RESTORE Act
- This should not be science lesson, but is an opportunity to speak strategically to the Committee
- Must provide presentations 1 week prior to meeting and ***include at least one element of each*** of these two broad categories:
 - Environment
 - Water Quality
 - Water Quantity
 - Habitat Improvement
 - Coastal Flood Protection/Coastal Resiliency
 - Sustainable Environment
 - Species Protection/Enhancement
 - Fisheries Sustainability
 - Economic
 - Tourism
 - Workforce Development/Job Creation
 - Port Improvements
 - Economic Diversity/Sustainability
 - Seafood Promotion
 - Recreational Fishing
 - Infrastructure Improvements

Examples: 1. How water quality improvements would impact/improve recreational fishing
2. How port improvements would have a net environmental gain/sustainability

Agree to coordinate presentation with other presenters to avoid duplication.

Limit presentations to 20 minutes with 10 minutes for questions
