



EMT / PARAMEDIC STUDENTS



Escambia County, Florida - ALS/BLS Medical Protocol

This protocol defines what skills and procedures EMT and Paramedic students are allowed to perform and when.


- A. EMT and Paramedic students are allowed to perform any BLS skills and/or procedures under the direct supervision of any Escambia County Public Safety EMT or Paramedic during their scheduled clinical time.
- B. Paramedic Students are only allowed to perform the ALS procedures during their scheduled clinical time while under the direct supervision of a Paramedic Field Training Officer and/or Supervisor and only then, when they have been cleared by the Paramedic Instructor to do the individual skill.
- C. The Director of the Paramedic Program shall provide the EMS Chief and Training Coordinator with list of the student and the skills that the students are allowed to perform at the beginning of every semester. (Usually by E-mail) The EMS Chief shall provide a copy to the EMS Supervisors for posting and file a copy for future reference.
- D. No Paramedic student will be allowed to do any ALS procedure at any other time, specifically those individuals who are employed here part time or full time and are working as an EMT with a certified Paramedic.
- E. Students are required to wear their assigned student uniform when riding with EMS.
