Returning Inmate from Main Jail



Purpose: This SOG defines criteria for inmates returning from the main jail to the Escambia County Road Prison.

Procedure: When an inmate has been sent to the main jail for any medical reason, the inmate must meet 3 criteria before being allowed to return to the Escambia County Road Prison.

1. Clearance to Escambia County Road Prison by the main jail medical doctor.
2. Clearance to return to work at the Road Prison in less than 7 days from the time of transfer.
3. Have any and all medications with him in blister packs so that the medications can be assigned to the inmate when he returns.

If any of the above criteria cannot be met the inmate is to remain at the main jail.
