Transportation Planning

Planning

- Technical Coordinating Committee (TCC) for Transportation Planning Organization (TPO). One of our staff is the Chairman.
- Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC)
- Development Review Committee (DRC) – Access Management
- Development Monitoring (DRC) – Roadway impacts due to development

Sidewalk Program

- Mainly governed by SRTS – within 2 mile radius of a school, but also includes interconnectivity.

Community or Neighborhood Enhancement Program

- Originally the Traffic Calming Program, now handled through MSBU, the NEP can incorporate sidewalks, street lighting, etc. within neighborhoods

Striping and Pavement Markings Program

- Revitalizing the striping and pavement markings on County roads based upon evaluation and/or program

Street Name Signs Program

- Monitoring and upgrading as necessary according to MUTCD

Traffic Operations

Signals

- Operate and maintain County and State facilities
- 180 Actuated
- 77 School Beacons
- 42 Intersection Beacons
- 10 Emergency Flashing Beacons
- 14 Radar Speed Limit Signs

Intelligent Transportation System (ITS)

- Working with FDOT on developing a regional system
- Implementation plan scope is in process

Operations

- Regulatory signs and other road signs
- Inspections
- Traffic evaluations (minor) and traffic counts
