


4 WARRANT FACTORS

Proximity to <u>Significant</u> Generators Only School/Church at Ave 17

Pedestrian – Vehicle Crash History *O Fatal/4 injury crashes at Ave 17*

Distance between Crossings 400 Feet to 1/3rd Mile

Pedestrian Demand More than 20 ped/hour- Ave 18 & 23
