

Construction Notice of Commencement

River Road Culvert Repairs (FEMA Project)



Project Overview

Escambia County's Construction Management Division will soon begin the River Road Culvert Repairs FEMA Project in District 1. This project consists of replacing an existing culvert crossing and associated asphalt roadway and multi-use path that were damaged during Hurricane Sally. The project area is located approximately 2,040 linear feet north of the intersection of River Road and Perdido Key Drive. Construction is expected to begin mid-May 2023 and be completed within 270 days, weather permitting.

Resident Information

- The project is funded by Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) funds with a construction cost of approximately \$1.4 Million
- Quality Enterprises USA, Inc. will be the contractor for this project.
- Construction is expected to take place during the hours of 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- River Road will be closed at the project site during construction and a detour route will be provided to general and local traffic.
- Areas impacted during construction will be returned to their previous state.
- Access to adjacent properties will be maintained, although there may be periods when a driveway or entrance is temporarily blocked during construction.
- An Escambia County Inspector will monitor the construction areas daily.
- We appreciate your cooperation and patience during this construction process.
